Call for Associate Academic Director (UC Tenured Faculty), 2015-16

Location: University of California Washington Center (UCDC), Washington, DC

The University of California Washington Center (UCDC) is recruiting to fill a limited number of Associate Academic Director positions for Academic Years 2015-16. UCDC is a system-wide academic program of the University of California in Washington, DC that provides opportunities for undergraduates to study and participate in public service, media, science policy and arts internships in Washington DC for a quarter or semester. Additionally, students carry a course load of academic work including participation in a core research seminar and elective courses.

Courses are designed to supplement student's internship experience and/or to take advantage of the many unique opportunities available in our nation's capital. Applicants must be active, tenured University of California faculty. Appointment as a UCDC Associate Academic Director requires a two-year commitment. These positions are in Washington, DC at the Washington Center. Residency in the Washington, DC area for the term of the appointment is a requirement. The usual teaching load for Associate Academic Directors is three quarter and one semester seminars of 25 students or less. Incumbents usually teach themed seminars in areas such as Congress, the Presidency, international policy, media, environment or general research seminars. Research seminars link research and writing assignments to the students' internships. Incumbents will also be expected to participate in local UCDC faculty committees or special assignments.

UCDC will provide one round trip airfare and subsidized housing (one bedroom apartment) at the UC Washington Center for the duration of the appointment.
